I have worked at Teatro alla Scala, Teatro Real Madrid, Den Jyske Opera, Brooklyn Academy of Music, Liceu Barcelona, The Chatelet, Paris, ROH, Glyndebourne Festival, Opera North, The Young Vic and The South Bank.

Work with young people and community groups has always played an important part in my work. I have made theatre and Opera with people of all ages and backgrounds for companies including Glyndebourne, The Young Vic, Guildhall School, BAC, Southwark Playhouse, Theatre 503, Peckham Shed and The Opera Group. I have worked with refugee groups, and those at risk of exclusion and have developed and delivered projects in pupil referral units.

Other experience

I have extensive experience of making work in **site specific** locations, including at The Corinthia Hotel, Brooklands Museum, British Museum, Battle Abbey and Gemaldegalerie Berlin. I am used to the challenging environments of sit-specific work and sites that have multiple uses. I am passionate about the creation of new opera and have been involved in the **dramaturgy** and development of a number of productions including a new version of 'Eugene Onegin,' for OperaUpClose, 'Belongings,' 'Trouser Power,' 'Musitatio,' and 'The Finding.' I have frequently worked to make high quality work for children and have been involved in the development of 'The Lost Thing,' 'The Firework Maker's Daughter,' and 'How the Whale became' for ROH, and 'Nothing,' and 'The Knight Crew' for Glyndebourne Education.
